The purpose of the driving school portion is to teach you to be a better driver, learn the characteristics of your car, and to have fun with fellow automotive enthusiasts. Each new student will be provided with an experienced in car instructor. Most instructors are either NASA or SCCA trained instructors. Your instructor is not here to drive your vehicle but rather lead, guide, and direct you to better handle your vehicle while driving in a closed, controlled environment.

Your instructor will provide you with feedback about your driving skill in a constructive positive manner. They will determine if you are ready to drive solo. They will also determine if you are ready to move up to a different group. This will depend on the skills and efforts you have demonstrated to them while driving the road course. Feel free to discuss any problems or concerns you have with your instructor; they are here to help you become a better driver. You must first get permission from your instructor to move up and then consult the lead instructor, Rick McNutt, for final approval.

We hope you will have a pleasant rewarding experience at the 2010 SVT Superfest at Virginia International Raceway and we look forward to having you back in October on the 16-17th for the SCMC/TCUSA on Track event at VIR full course. Let's have a safe, fun weekend at the track!
